



Which German courses are available?

There are:

- general integration courses
 - Job related German courses in particular DeuFöV-professional language courses in cooperation with the jobcenter and the agency for work as well as financial support from the Federal Office for Migration and Refugees (BAMF)
 - special courses for asylum seekers
 - small groups or individual courses
 - company courses
 - online courses

Who can participate in integration courses?

All people who have recently immigrated to Germany, asylum seekers and foreigners who have been living in Germany for a long time can participate.

**Do I need to take a placement test?**

Yes, you must take a placement test (approximately 45 minutes) before registering. With the help of the test result, we will find the right course for you.

What is an integration course?

An integration course is a German course with a total of 700 teaching units (á 45 minutes); 600 hours of language course and 100 hours of German culture, history and politics. Integration courses are financially supported by the BAMF.

When will the integration courses take place?

At the moment courses take place in the morning (5 or 4 times a week) or in the evening (3 or 4 times a week).

New courses usually start every 6 to 8 weeks. The current dates can be found on our homepage:

**Who can participate in integration courses?**

All people who have recently immigrated to Germany, asylum seekers and foreigners who have been living in Germany for a long time can participate.

What exams can I take at the vhs?

After the integration course, you can take the DIZ-German test for immigrants (A2 - B1) and the orientation course test (living in Germany). In addition, B2 tests are held regularly.

What does A1, A2, B1, B2...mean?

The letters stand for the language level. This describes how well you can speak, write and understand a language.

What do I have to bring to register?

You must bring your ID/passport and possibly your bank details and a permit for the integration course. You can obtain the permit from the foreign authority, the Landratsamt, Jobcenter or from the Federal Office for Migration and Refugees (BAMF). In the case of EU citizens, the authorization certificate is applied for by the vhs.

What do I have to pay for the integration course?

With a permit, you receive a cost exemption or financial support from the Federal Office for Migration and Refugees.
